**SCHEDULING ORDER: REVISIONS TO
EXISTING SCHEDULING ORDERS**

AND NOW, this 31st day of July, 2013, now that the evidentiary record in this matter is closed, it is **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that Scheduling Orders III and IV are amended as set forth below:

Scheduling Order III is **AMENDED**¹ as to post-trial briefs and post-trial practice in Paragraphs 5 and 6.

¹ Scheduling Order III-A is also revised as a consequence.

The last sentence of Paragraph 5 is revised as follows:

Post-trial briefs, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, together with full record citations in support, shall be filed within **thirty (30) days** of the close of the record.

The last sentence of Paragraph 6 is revised as follows:

Post-trial motions may be decided by a panel of the Court.

Scheduling Order IV is **AMENDED** as to the timeline for resolving any motion to continue or modify the preliminary injunction, from August 9, 2013 to **August 19, 2013**.
